Other observations

- Many teachers (64%) agree that infrastructural facilities are OK in the department but few (18%) disagree.
- Many agree that test and examinations are conducted well in time with proper coverage of all units in the syllabus , including assignment and project works.
- About 27% teachers disagree with the experience of adoption of new techniques of teaching.
- Most teachers agree that the environment in the department is conducive to teaching and research
- Over 80% teachers say that the administration in the college is teachers friendly.

Actions Taken

- Steps have been taken to upgrade infrastructural facilities. Massive repair work has been carried out in the entire college to bring the basic infrastructural facilities at par with the best one in the state. Cleaning work has been done despite the shortage of permanent staffs. For this many contractual workers have been employed time to time.
- Many disagree with the new techniques of teaching because of lack of computer knowledge. They are advised to train themselves in an appropriate refresher course.
- Teachers are encouraged to bring funding through various research proposals.
- Regular interactions among teachers at various forums are helping to bring the best of the administration and friendly environment.

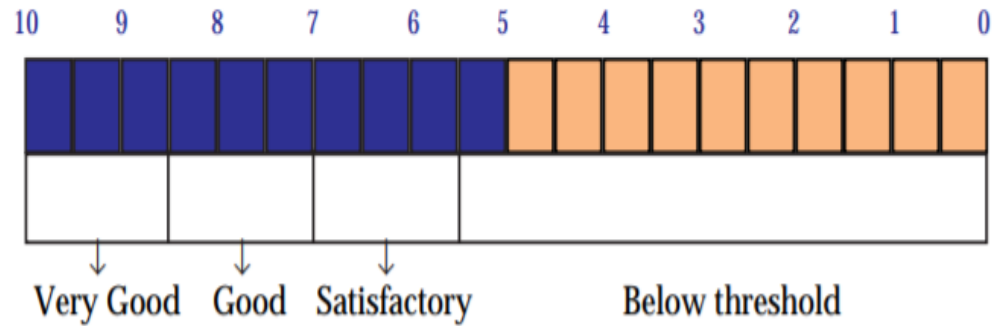

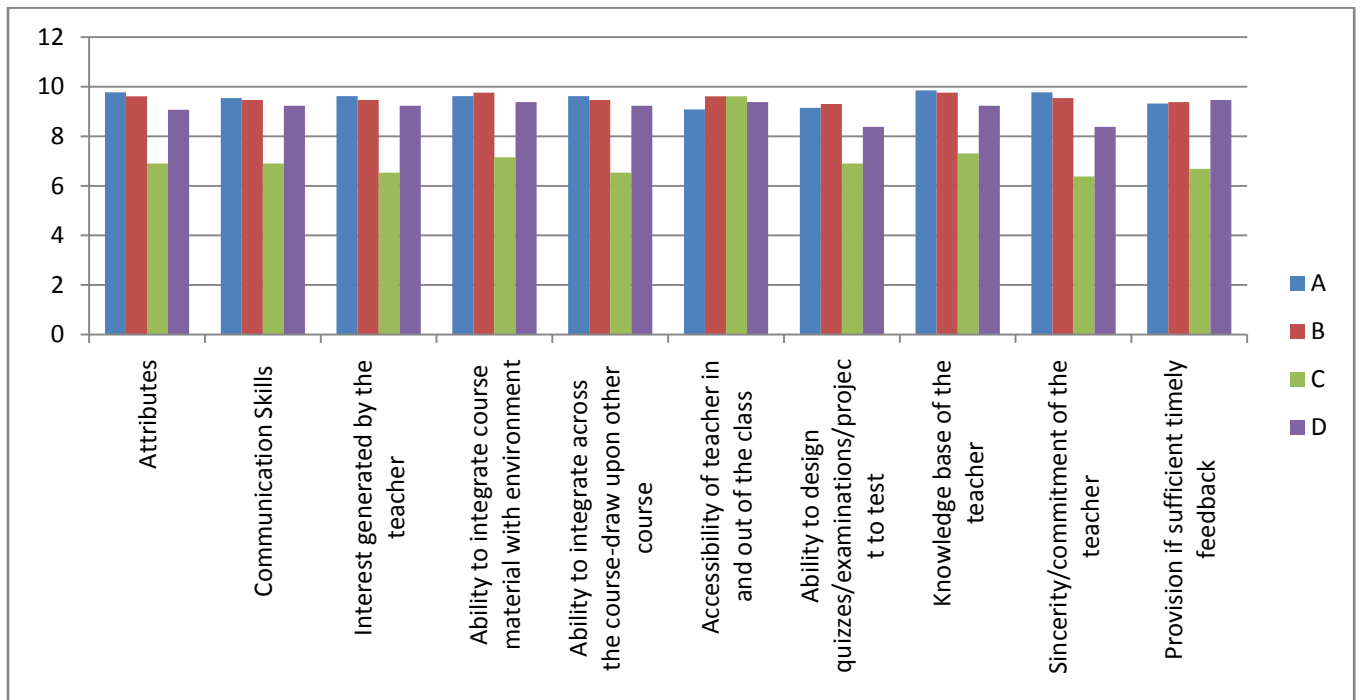


Student Satisfaction Survey of Geology Department

Teacher's codes are A, B, C, D for Part I. Average Scores are mentioned on the Y-axis.

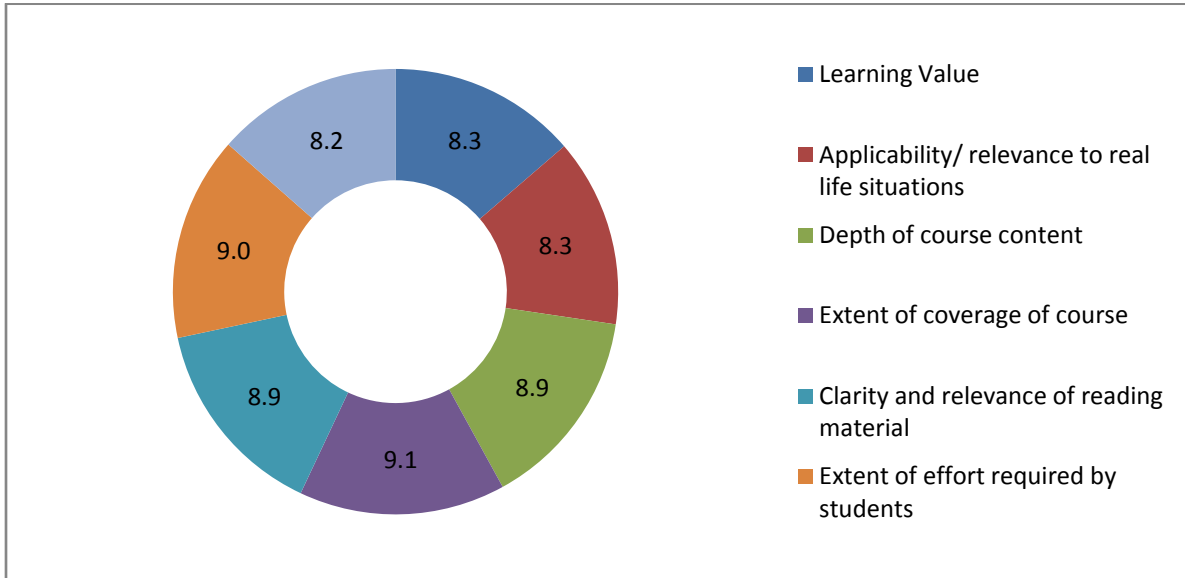
