**ORDINANCE & REGULATIONS FOR THE BACHELOR OF ARTS/  
SCIENCE/COMMERCE (HONOURS)**  
**PROGRAMME UNDER CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM (C.B.C.S.)**

**Ordinance for Admission**

1. This ordinance shall be known as "**Ordinance for Admission**" in the Bachelor of Arts (Honours)/Science (Honours)/Commerce (Honours) of Patna University.
2. The Bachelor Programme shall be undertaken in Six Semesters within three years.
3. It will come into effect from the Academic Session 2022-23.
4. The eligibility criterion for admission in Bachelor programmes are listed in Table 1.

**Table 1:** Eligibility criterion for admission in Bachelor programme

Candidates who have passed intermediate examination I.A./ I.Sc./ I.Com or +2 of Bihar School Examination Board or equivalent examination offered by other approved Boards (CBSE/ ICSE/ other State Board) with at least 45% marks in aggregate.	Candidates who have passed intermediate examination I.Sc. or +2 of Bihar School Examination Board or equivalent examination offered by other approved Boards (CBSE/ ICSE/ other State Board) with at least 45% marks in aggregate.	Candidates who have passed intermediate examination I.A./ I.Sc./ I.Com. or +2 of Bihar School Examination Board or equivalent examination offered by other approved Boards (CBSE/ ICSE/ other State Board) with at least 45% marks in aggregate.

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5. Admission to the first semester of the Bachelor programme shall be made on the basis of marks obtained by the candidate at the Common Admission Entrance Test (CAET) conducted by the University or marks obtained in +2 examinations as decided by the Academic Council of the University.
6. The Admission Entrance Test Booklet will consist of 100 multiple choice type questions. The **Part A** of the Admission Entrance Test Booklet will consist of **40 multiple choice type questions** from General Knowledge, General Aptitude and Numerical Aptitude.

The **Part B** will consist of **60 multiple choice type questions** from all major subjects of Humanities and Social Science.

The **Part C** will consist of **60 multiple choice type questions** from all major subjects of Science.

The **Part D** will consist of **60 multiple choice type questions** from all major subjects of Commerce.

Part A of the Admission Entrance Test Booklet will be common for all and students may choose any one from Part B, Part C and Part D. There will be a Common merit list and students shall have the option to choose the programme from the list offered by Patna University. Students shall fill in their choices. Finally, the programme will be allotted on the basis of their merit cum choice. The duration of the test shall be of two hours.

7. The candidate seeking admission shall have to apply online on the Patna University web portal after paying the requisite fee mentioned in the advertisement notice published by the University. The candidate shall have to upload the documents supporting his/her claim mentioned in the application form.

**Note:** No applicant shall be admitted to the program who has not applied for admission within the notified period.

8. **Fee structure:** The breakup of fees per semester is given in Table 2.

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

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

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9. The revision of the fee structure may be made every 3<sup>rd</sup> year after seeking the approval of the statutory bodies of the University.

**10. Reservation**

The reservation of seats in the Bachelor programme shall be made in terms of the reservation rule approved by the government for its implementation in the University.

**Note:**

- (i) A candidate shall have to mention the category in the main application form specifically and must upload the supporting document to substantiate his/her claim.
  - (ii) An application without a category option shall be treated as under unreserved category.
  - (iii) An application with an entry of the wrong option under category shall be treated under the unreserved category.
  - (iv) For allotment of seats under other different quota (Sports/Fine Arts/ Defense/ Staff etc.) will be made as per Memo No. PU-18/99-3944/GS(I) dated: 28.08.1999.
11. In case any document submitted by a candidate at the time of admission to this programme is/are found to be fake or fraud, the admission of the candidate shall stand cancelled, and the fee deposited by the candidate is also forfeited.
  12. Any candidate can be denied admission, or his/her name will be struck off from the roll of the University if necessarily required in the best interest of the University.
  13. The candidates shall not be allowed to register for any other degree programme in the same University or any other University during the same academic session of his/her study in the Bachelor programme.
  14. Any student who attended all courses/papers in a Semester as a regular student and sent up for the End Semester Examination (ESE) but fails to appear in the ESE shall have to appear in the subsequent forthcoming examination of a particular semester by paying the requisite examination fee.
  15. A student has attendance less than 75% in any course/paper, then the candidate has to repeat the particular course/paper in the subsequent forthcoming examination by paying the proportionate fee of that semester as decided by University.
  16. If a candidate has an attendance of 75% or more but fails in the CIA, in that case, the candidate has to appear for CIA in that particular course/paper in the subsequent forthcoming examination.



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17. Every student should fill a registration form before the start of next semester.
18. Minor changes in the above ordinance may be made by the Academic Council if required in the interest of academics.
19. The general ordinance of Patna University shall cover any aspect not covered in the present ordinance.



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## Regulations for Examination

1.1. These regulations should be called the "**Regulations of Examination**" for the Bachelor program of Patna University under the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) Curriculum.

1.2. It shall come into force from the Academic Year 2022-23.

1.3. The B.A. (Hons) program shall come under the "Faculty of Arts", B.Sc. (Hons) under "Faculty of Science" and B.Com.(Hons) under "Faculty of Commerce".

### **2. OUTLINE OF THE CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM (CBCS):**

It consists of a number of courses, i.e. **Core Course (CC)**, **Generic Elective Course (GE)**, **Discipline Specific Elective Course (DSE)**, **Skill/ Ability Enhancement Courses (SEC)**, and **Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC)**. The nature of these courses is defined below:

#### **2.1.1. Core Course (CC):**

A course that a candidate should study as a core requirement of the Bachelor programme is termed a Core course.

#### **2.1.2. Discipline Specific Elective Course (DSE):**

Elective courses may be offered by the main discipline/subject of study is referred to as **Discipline Specific Elective**. Students must opt for Dissertation/Project/ Internship/ Industrial Training as one of the DSE Courses in 6<sup>th</sup> Semester.

#### **2.1.3. Generic Elective (GE) Course:**

An elective course chosen generally from an unrelated discipline/subject, with an intention to seek broad exposure, is called a **Generic Elective**.

#### **2.1.4. Ability/Skill Enhancement Courses (AEC/SEC):**

The Ability Enhancement Courses / Skill Enhancement Courses (AEC/SEC). "AEC/SEC" courses are the courses based upon the content that leads to skill enhancement.

#### **2.1.5. Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC):**

University will run **Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC)**. These courses are based upon the content that leads to knowledge enhancement.

### **3. Program of Study/ Course Structure:**

3.1. Students shall undergo a certified program of study extending up to six semesters in three academic years.



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3.2. Each academic year shall consist of two semesters:

Odd semesters (I, III, V) from July to December

Even semester (II, IV, VI) from January to June

3.3. The Bachelor program will consist of a number of courses as per **Annexure**, spanning over six semesters.

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- 3.4. To maintain Uniform academic accountability, certain weightage is assigned in the form of "Credit", separately for each course per semester depending upon the length of the Curriculum. 10 hours of teaching has been fixed for each credit as on average.
- 3.5. The Bachelor program shall have 140 credits altogether. The CGPA shall be awarded on the candidate's performance in all papers/courses (CC, DSE, GE, SEC and AECC) as mentioned in Tables included in Annexure 1.1 to Annexure 1.26 of the programme (subject) concerned.
- 3.6. The syllabus of the programme may be revised as per the demand of different stakeholders by BOCS and duly approved by the Academic Council.

#### 4. Elective Courses:

4.1 The distribution of the ten elective papers shall be – Two (2) SEC, Four (4) GE, Four (4) DSE. Students may opt for any elective course out of a list of elective papers (**Basket**) offered by the parent department or any other department/s as per his/her choice with the prior permission of the parent department. The list of elective papers, syllabus and prerequisite of the elective course will be as decided by the Board of Courses of Studies (BOCS) of the concerned subject/ department and duly approved by Academic Council.

4.2 UG Courses offered by SWAYAM/MOOC related to Discipline Specific and Skill enhancement not studied as core course/paper may be selected by the candidate with the approval of the Department.

Students undertaking UG course from SWAYAM shall be eligible for credit transfer if he/she gets a certificate for successful completion from SWAYAM.

#### 5. Evaluation of Performance Under C.B.C.S.

5.1 Any student admitted to Bachelor programme and registered in the University shall be eligible to appear at the University Examination for each Semester only after securing 75% attendance both in theory and practical class separately and also passed in all CIA.

5.2 The University Examination of each course in all semesters shall have two components:

- i. Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) of CC, GE and DSE containing 30 marks
- ii. Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) of AECC and SEC containing 50 marks



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- iii. End Semester Examination (ESE) of CC, GE and DSE containing 70 marks.
- iv. End Semester Examination (ESE) of AECC and SEC containing 50 marks.

- 5.3 The CIA component of the Examination shall be conducted by the department under a concerned teacher of the course/paper and will be responsible for the submission of CIA marks after evaluation to the Head of the Department.
- 5.4 Only End Semester Examination (ESE) shall be conducted by the University. The ESE of theory courses/papers shall be a written examination of 3 hours duration. However, the ESE of Practical and Project dissertation viva-voce shall be conducted in the respective Department.
- 5.5 The evaluation of the Project Dissertation will also be based on CIA and an end-semester examination.
- 5.6 All such examinations shall be as per the provisions of the Examination Board and Moderation Board of the University.

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## 6. Examinations

6.1 The End-Semester-Examination will be conducted by the University.

### Question Paper Pattern

The question paper shall consist of three parts-

- Part A – Compulsory – consisting of objective/ multiple choice type - each carrying two marks 20 marks
- Part B – Short Answer Type – Four questions to be answered out of six questions - each carrying five marks 20 marks
- Part C – Long Answer Type - Three questions to be answered out of Five questions - each carrying ten marks 30 marks

6.2 The candidate's performance in the examination for the Bachelor programme shall be evaluated following the Uniform Grading system (Credits) formulated on the guidelines of UGC on the computation of Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA).

6.3 The examination of odd semesters I, III and V shall generally be held in November and December and that of even semesters II, IV and VI in the month of April-May.

6.4 Paper setting work for End Semester Examination (both theory and practical) shall be done by external experts, out of which 50% may be from Patna University.

6.5 The evaluation of the answer script of all ESE courses shall be made centralized in the University with the assistance of duly approved external examiners, whose names have been approved by the University. Before evaluation, the answer script of the candidates must be coded. After completing the entire evaluation, the coded marks shall be decoded and accordingly, the result will be published.

## 7 **Passing of Examinations and Promotional Rules:**

7.1 There shall be no supplementary examination in any of the courses/papers in any semester.

7.2 The candidates who have been admitted to the First Semester of a three year Undergraduate Programme in a session can be placed in the following categories based on their attendance in the Semester and performance in CIA.



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- i. Those who have cleared the CIA and attended the required minimum percentage (75%) of attendance shall appear in the ESE.
- ii. Those who have not attended the required minimum percentage of attendance (75%) and not cleared CIA shall in no case be permitted to appear in the End Semester Examination.
- 7.3** After appearing at the End Semester Examination, the candidates can be placed in the following categories in the context of the declaration of the Semester Examination results.
- i. To be declared passed in End Semester Examination, a candidate must secure at least a 'P' grade as mentioned in Table-4 in each course/paper separately in CIA and ESE.
- ii. A candidate may be promoted to next semester based on the following criteria as given in Table-3.

**Table 3: Promotion Criteria**

1	From Semester-I to Semester-II	Attended all courses in Semester-I as a regular student and sent up** for the Semester-I examination.
2	From Semester-II to Semester-III	Attended all courses in Semester-I and Semester-II as a regular student. The candidate must earn at least 28 credits of Semester-I and II taken together in CC, GE and AECC.
3	From Semester-III to Semester-IV	Attended all courses in Semester-III as a regular student and sent up** for the Semester-III examination.
4	From Semester-IV to Semester- V	Attended all courses in Semester-IV as a regular student and sent up** for the Semester-IV examination The candidate must earn at least 70 credits of Semester-I, II, III and IV taken together in CC, AECC, GE and SEC.
5	From Semester-V to Semester-VI	Attended all courses in Semester-V as a regular student and sent up** for the Semester-V examination. The candidate must earn 116 credits taken together in CC, DSE, AECC, GE and SEC.

\*\*Sent up for End Semester Examination here refers to those candidates who have a minimum of 75% attendance in each course/paper separately and cleared the CIA of respective course/paper conducted by the Department.






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- iii. Candidates shall have to clear their backlog course/paper (s) in the subsequent end semester examination of that semester whenever it is available.
- iv. The Final result will be published only after he/she has cleared all 140 credits.
- v. Since it is a continuous evaluation programme, a student shall be awarded Semester Grade Points (SGPA) at the end of the first semester Examination, and in the subsequent semesters till the fifth semester, and finally, in the sixth Semester the result will be awarded based on CGPA. No grade points will be awarded if there is any backlog present.
- vi. A student has to score a minimum grade P in his/her CIA. Failing to secure minimum marks, he/she shall have to repeat the CIA along with the students of the same semester of the next academic session.
- vii. The promoted candidate/candidates will not be awarded any SGPA/CGPA till he/she clears all the backlogs.
- viii. A promoted candidate, if he/she has passed in CIA but fails in ESE, he/she shall retain his/her CIA score and will reappear in the ESE only of the semester whenever available.
- ix. Students undertaking any UG course from SWAYAM as SEC or DSE shall be eligible for credit transfer if he/she gets a certificate for successful completion from SWAYAM.
- x. The candidate must clear the programme within maximum of five years. Academic Council may give one additional year of relaxation in case of exceptional circumstances.

**Note- Special Provision:**

In case of serious health problems and other strictly unavoidable circumstances, relaxation in required attendance might be condoned up to a maximum 15%, and in no case, a leaning will be entitled to avail condonation beyond.

**9. Improvement of Result:**

If a candidate clears Semesters I, II, III, IV and V ESE, he/she may apply for the improvement of his/her result in a maximum of two courses/papers of the entire Programme. He/she can avail this facility only in theory papers. The better of the two results will be treated as the final result of candidates in those papers.

**10. Declaration of Result:**

The Teacher/Examination Department shall use the following grading system:



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Results in the form of grade points consequent upon evaluation will be awarded in the following two manners-

- I. At the end of each semester which will be titled as Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA).
- II. At the end of the programme, which will be titled Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA). The explanations for publishing results in the form of Grade points is given in Table-5.

The grading system stated below shall be used at the time of preparation of the result of the candidates who appeared at the examination

- There shall be a Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA) for each semester based on the Grade obtained in that Semester. The SGPA for every Semester is calculated as:

$$SGPA = \frac{\sum_{i=1}^n m_i o_i}{\sum_{i=1}^n o_i}$$

n – number of courses in a said semester

m<sub>i</sub>- the numerical value of grade obtained in the said semester


o<sub>i</sub>- number of credits for the said semester

The calculations of SGPA and CGPA is illustrated below as an example:




